FOOTNOTES:

- 1 Skate complex landings are not reported because this is a species complex (group). The U.S. National Bycatch Report does not use landings for complexes since species in the bycatch complex may be different than species in the landings complex, even though the complex name is the same.
- 2 Atlantic wolffish, ocean pout, and red deepsea crab landings are confidential; landings and bycatch ratios are not reported for these species.
- 3 Species bycatch ratios are not reported for ESA fish species such as Atlantic salmon.
 - a In the First Edition of the National Bycatch Report, Acadian redfish was referred to as redfish (see NMFS. 2011. U.S. national bycatch report (W. A. Karp, L. L. Desfosse, S. G. Brooke, editors).  - b Atlantic cod has two stocks: Gulf of Maine and Georges Bank.
 - c Retention of Atlantic salmon is prohibited under the ESA.
 - d Atlantic wolffish was added to the Northeast Multispecies FMP when Amendment 16 was implemented on May 1, 2010. Atlantic wolffish was not examined in the First Edition of the National Bycatch Report (NMFS 2011).
 - e Goosefish has two stocks: Gulf of Maine / Northern Georges Bank and Southern Georges Bank / Mid-Atlantic.
 - f In the First Edition of the National Bycatch Report (NMFS 2011) goosefish was referred to as monkfish.
 - g Haddock has two stocks: Gulf of Maine and Georges Bank.

- h In the First Edition of the National Bycatch Report (NMFS 2011) longfin inshore squid was referred to as longfinned squid.
- i In the First Edition of the National Bycatch Report (NMFS 2011) northern shortfin squid was referred to as shortfin squid, northern.
- j In the First Edition of the National Bycatch Report (NMFS 2011) red deepsea crab was referred to as deep sea red crab.
- k Red hake has two stocks: Gulf of Maine / Northern Georges Bank and Southern Georges Bank / Middle Atlantic.
- l In the First Edition of the National Bycatch Report (NMFS 2011) sea scallop was referred to as Atlantic sea scallop.
- m Silver hake has two stocks: Gulf of Maine / Northern Georges Bank and Southern Georges Bank / Middle Atlantic.
- n Skate Complex (Scientific name: *Rajidae*) is comprised of seven species in addition to unidentified skates: barndoor skate (*Dipturus laevis*), clearnose skate (*Raja eglanteria*), little skate (*Leucoraja erinacea*), rosette skate (*Leucoraja garmani*), smooth skate (*Malacoraja senta*), thorny skate (*Amblyraja radiata*), and winter skate (*Leucoraja ocellata*).
- p Windowpane has two stocks: Gulf of Maine / Georges Bank and Southern New England / Mid-Atlantic.
- q In the First Edition of the National Bycatch Report (NMFS 2011) windowpane was referred to as windowpane flounder.
- r Winter flounder has three stocks: Gulf of Maine, Georges Bank, and Southern New England / Mid-Atlantic.
- s Yellowtail flounder has three stocks: Georges Bank, Cape Cod / Gulf of Maine, and Southern New England / Mid-Atlantic.
